## WHAT DOES VALLEY COMMUNITIES CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Whv?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number
- Account balances
- Payment history
- Transaction history
- Credit history
- Wire transfer instructions

How?

All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons Valley Communities Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Reasons we can share your personal information	Does Valley Communities Credit Union share?	Can you limit this sharing?
For our everyday business purposes— such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus	Yes	No

What We Do		
How does Valley Communities Credit Union protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.	
	We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.	
How does Valley Communities Credit Union collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you  Open an account Pay us by check Apply for a loan Show your driver's license Make deposits or withdrawals from your account We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.	
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only  sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness  affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.	
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.	
Information that is collected spe	cific to your CardSecur app.	
Collected Information	We may collect information regarding your mobile device such as device settings, unique device identifiers, information about your location, and analytical information that may assist with diagnostics and performance For your convenience, you may be asked to grant permission for access to your mobile device's geolocation data. This information may be collected when you use certain services that are dependent on your mobile device's location (such as the location of an ATM or in store transactions).	
Definitions		
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul> <li>Valley Communities Credit Union has no affiliates</li> </ul>	
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  Nonaffiliates we share with can include Insurance company.	
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.  Valley Communities Credit Union doesn't jointly market.
