BEWARE OF SCAM

• HOW TO AVOID SCAMS

Sadly, scams are an ever-growing problem in our society. We would like to believe everyone only has the best intentions, but that isn't always the case.

Protect yourself from being victimized by:

1.) Blocking all unwanted calls and texts.

- 2.) Refusing to give out personal information on calls or emails you weren't expecting. (Government agencies like the IRS will not call you and will not ask for your Social Security number over the phone.)
- 3.) Refusing to act immediately upon a request, no matter the pressure to do so. Scammers will attempt to make you feel like you need to act at that exact moment, but YOU DON'T.
- 4.) Stopping the encounter to talk to someone you trust. VCCU's friendly staff always looks out for your best interest. If you receive a phone call or an email that feels fishy, we would be more than happy to talk with you about it. Scammers constantly adapt and change their attack methods. You can always bring us your questions about a potential scam. Your financial security is important to us.



Debt consolidation is a great way to take control of your finances. Carrying debt on multiple credit cards could cost you dearly in interest.

Consolidating your debt simplifies monthly payments to multiple creditors into one monthly payment, often at a lower interest rate.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR TAX REFUNDS

To avoid delays on direct deposits of your tax refunds, make sure to use the correctly formatted account number. Wrong account numbers may cause returns to be sent back to the IRS.

VCCU's routing number is **275980735**. Your ACH/ digital account number is the 10-digit number at the bottom of your check that begins with "0." The full 10-digits must be used. See the example to right. If you don't have checks, or want to deposit your refund to another account, please contact your local VCCU branch for assistance, or send us a message through NetBranch for assistance.
