AVOID SCAMS

In today's world, scams and other threats are an ever-growing problem. With the rise of artificial intelligence (AI) and other technologies, determining whether something is legitimate can be more complex and challenging. VCCU has a few tips and tricks to help you protect yourself.

- 1.) With the rise of Al-generated voice programs, scammers can sound like your loved ones asking for help. The easiest way to protect yourself from this is to set up a secret code that only you and your family will know. This could be anything from the name of your child's first dog to your favorite quote from a movie or book. Make it specific to your family and not something that would be widely known.
- 2.) Block all unknown or spam phone calls and texts.
- 3.) Never act on any request immediately; take the time to validate any person or organization.
- 4.) Do not give out personal information on calls or emails you weren't expecting. Government agencies like the IRS will never call you and ask for your Social Security number.

If you ever get a call, email, or mail that doesn't seem right, our trained staff is always willing to go over it with you. Your financial security is important to us.

• IMPORTANT TAX • REFUNDS INFORMATION

To avoid delays in receiving your tax refunds through direct deposit, make sure to use the correctly formatted account number. Wrong account numbers may cause returns to be sent back to the IRS.

VCCU's routing number is **275980735**. Your ACH/digital account number is the 10-digit number at the bottom of your check that begins with "0." The full 10 digits must be used. See the example below.

If you don't have checks or want to deposit your refund to another account, please contact your local VCCU branch for assistance or send us a message through Virtual Branch online banking.
