BILL PAY* lets you pay one-time or recurring bills with ease. Schedule reminders or payments in advance to ensure they are received on time. Plus you can keep all your payee information in one convenient place without any paper clutter. And it's more secure — your check won't get lost in the mail.

A2A**, or Account to Account transfer lets you move funds from one account to another account that you have at different financial institution. Make transfers anytime, anywhere you can even schedule to have money transferred regularly.

POPMONEY** personal payment service lets you send and receive money — with friends, family or anyone. All you need is a person's name and email address or mobile telephone number, and you can move money between your VCCU account and theirs. It's great for sending money to a child at college, money for a wedding gift, paying for a local service like babysitters, or sending rent to a landlord.
